## Juried Crafts:

1. All work for sale in your booth must be handmade by the vendor(s) who applied.
2. No pets other than working service dogs.
3. Styrofoam materials must be carried out, not disposed of on site. No helium balloons.
4. Vendors supply their own chairs, tables, displays, extension cords, rain cover if outside the crafts tent.
5. Fires may be made in campground fire pits and grills only.
6. Those camping with their booths must take down their tents by 8:30am each day.
7. Park closes at 11 pm on Friday. Vehicles may not drive in or out between 11 pm Fri. and 6 am Sat.
8. In an effort to avoid traffic delays that we experienced in past years, vendor/exhibitor cars will ONLY be allowed on the festival site to unload until 8AM on Saturday, June 16. Any vendors arriving after 8AM will be required to use carts and hand-trucks to bring materials on-site. All vendor/exhibitor vehicles must be removed from the site by 8:30AM. If your car is not removed by then, the Parks Department will not allow the festival to open the gates for the audience. You may not re-enter the festival site on Saturday and Sunday nights until a Clearwater coordinator has instructed you.
9. If you arrive by car after 8:30AM on Saturday or Sunday there is no guarantee you will be able to park on-site. You may need to park at the train station and take the shuttle.
10. Vendors may not give their space to another vendor without permission from the crafts coordinators.
11. CDs and DVDs may not be sold in the crafts area.

Thank you for your interest in Clearwater's 2012 Great Hudson River Revival! This year, the crafts area will continue to be located near the Dance Tent in the South Field.
