At Camp Clearwater students will gain knowledge of and respect for the natural world. All of our program elements are facilitated by highly trained, nurturing and experienced staff. We start at a beginner level and increase with gained experience. Program Elements

Our programs are continuous, multi-element, overnight adventures. During adventure components, students sleep in tents, learn low-impact camping, and outdoor cooking skills. When transitioning between adventure components students will return to camp, where they will sleep in cabins, have access to showers, and communicate with love ones. They will engage in various educational programs as well as in traditional camp activities.

Backpacking

Students will learn “leave no trace” practices and land navigation. This will develop principles of environmental stewardship and build self-confidence.

Native American Fur Trader Canoe Experience

History and the culture of the Native Americans from the Hudson River Valley will be taught. Participants will explore the Hudson River while on a 32-foot Native American Fur Trader Canoe.

Kayaking

The group will complete a full day of training, then embark on a multi-day expedition in tandem sea kayaks. Along the way they will explore the life and history of the Hudson River and participate in water ecology activities.
