



## This Week on the Sloop

March 24-31, 2016


This week, we saw major changes on the sloop! We installed the engine beds and the first couple of hull planks and ceiling planks on the starboard side. We also began installing the timbers of the centerboard trunk and we're nearing the end of installing frames on the port side!



The engine is ready to be lowered onto its newly installed beds.



We fastened a couple of planks on the port side, which we had taken off. The rest of the planks will be made new. The planks are held on by galvanized steel nails.



In addition to hull planking, we have a lot of ceiling (the planking inside the frames) to replace.



Here you can see more new frames in the bosuns locker. On the left side of the photo, you'll see the first two timbers of the centerboard trunk in place. The one sitting on top is ready to be installed on the starboard side.
