PROTECTIVE ORDER

For good cause shown, the parties jointly request and the Court enters the following Protective

Order:

#### 1. **DEFINITIONS**

- a. "Petitioners" shall mean all named parties who brought this proceeding and remained Petitioners-Plaintiffs following this Court's January 22, 2018 Order granting Respondents' motions to dismiss, specifically (1) Hudson River Sloop Clearwater, Inc.; (2) Goshen Green Farms LLC; (3) Nuclear Information and Resource Service ("NIRS"); (4) Indian Point Safe Energy Coalition ("IPSEC"); (5) Promoting Health and Sustainable Energy, Inc. ("PHASE").
- b. "Constellation Respondents" shall mean (1) Constellation Energy Nuclear Group,
   LLC, with Subsidiaries and affiliates (2) Exelon Generation Company, LLC; (3)
   R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant, LLC; and (4) Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station,
   LLC.
- c. "PSC" shall mean the New York State Public Service Commission.
- d. "Constellation Confidential Information" shall mean all documents filed by the Constellation Respondents with the PSC in docket numbers 15-E-0302 and 16-E-0270 for which the Constellation Respondents sought "confidential" and/or "trade secrets" treatment pursuant to New York Public Officers Law (POL) § 89(5), POL § 87(2), and 16 N.Y.C.R.R. § 6-1.3, and which the PSC has provided to the Court on a designated CD-ROM for *in camera* review by the Court only. Constellation Confidential Information shall include not only the documents themselves, but any copies thereof, notes made from such documents, and the specific information contained in the documents.

#### 2. Access to Constellation Confidential Information

a. Prior to any disclosure of Constellation Confidential Information to any individual or representative, the individual to whom disclosure is to be made shall

- acknowledge receipt of a copy of this Protective Order and execute an Agreement to be Bound by the Protective Order, in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- b. Six outside counsel for Petitioners specifically, Susan Shapiro, John Parker and Melanie Golden of Rockland Environmental Group, LLC, Seth Davis of Elias Group LLP, Rosanne Felicello of CKR Law LLP, and Saul Rigberg - shall be granted access to the Constellation Confidential Information following transmission of an executed copy of Exhibit A to outside counsel for the Constellation Respondents and counsel for the PSC at the addresses provided below. As detailed in Exhibit A, outside counsel for Petitioners must agree to limit disclosure of the Constellation Confidential Information to (a) Court personnel; (b) the PSC; (c) the Constellation Respondents; (d) employees of outside counsel providing logistical support to outside counsel; (e) Tim Judson, Executive Director of Petitioner NIRS, upon transmission of an executed Exhibit A to the Constellation Respondents and the PSC; (f) Petitioners' potential expert or consultant Mark Cooper, of the Institute for Energy and the Environment, upon transmission of an executed Exhibit A to the Constellation Respondents and the PSC; and (g) any other person or party upon written consent by both the Constellation Respondents and the PSC.
- c. Nothing in this Protective Order shall bar or otherwise restrict any attorney from rendering advice to his or her client with respect to this proceeding or from relying upon his or her examination of documents. In rendering such advice or in otherwise communicating with this or her client, the attorney shall not, except as

- otherwise permitted by this Protective Order, disclose the content of any Constellation Confidential Information.
- d. The Petitioners may request from the Constellation Respondents permission to disclose Constellation Confidential Information to two experts or subject matter consultants in addition to Mark Cooper. Constellation Respondents and the PSC shall not unreasonably withhold consent to such a request if, once such material has been reviewed by outside counsel, Petitioners' counsel can show that it is necessary to disclose such material to any such person in order to enable that Petitioners fully to advance their case, each designated individual is deemed necessary to aid counsel in the prosecution of this case, and each designated individual is not associated with a competitor of the Constellation Respondents or an industry participant. If any of Constellation Respondents or the PSC denies a Petitioner's request or fails to answer such request within 10 days of receipt of such request, Petitioners may then seek permission from the Court to disclose the Constellation Confidential Information to the expert or subject matter consultant. The Constellation Respondents and the PSC shall have an opportunity to object to and be heard on any such application. In all events, no designated expert or subject matter consultant shall have access to the Constellation Confidential Information prior to that person's execution of Exhibit A, and the transmission of an executed copy of Exhibit A to the Constellation Respondents and the PSC.
- e. When filing any Constellation Confidential Information with the Court,

  Petitioners shall prepare and file versions that include and omit the Constellation

  Confidential Information (the "Unredacted Version" and the "Redacted Version,"

respectively). Unredacted Versions must bear a conspicuous notation on each page that they contain Constellation Confidential Information and must be filed with the Court only under seal. The Redacted Version should be filed publicly at the same time.

### 3. Authorized Use

The Constellation Confidential Information may be used only in connection with the above-captioned litigation and not for any other purpose whatsoever, including without limitation any other litigation, political activities, media campaigns or any business or competitive purpose or function.

#### 4. Storage of Constellation Confidential Information

- a. No duplication or reproduction of Constellation Confidential Information may be made beyond that which is necessary to give access to the persons authorized by the provisions of this Protective Order. Persons who are provided with access to the Constellation Confidential Information pursuant to this Protective Order may take notes regarding such information to the extent necessary in connection with these proceedings. The protections afforded to Constellation Confidential Information apply not only to the original provided document or file in which it was contained, and any copies thereof, but also to any subsequent documents, notes, recordings, electronic files, or other media in which it may be recorded, including copies generated by automated back-up systems for computer workstation and network data storage devices.
- b. Persons having custody of any Constellation Confidential Information pursuant to this Protective Order must keep all copies and notes of Constellation Confidential

Information segregated physically under lock, electronically under password protection or encryption, and otherwise properly secured when such Constellation Confidential Information is not being reviewed.

## 5. Unauthorized Disclosure

- a. If a person subject to this Protective Order believes that the Constellation Confidential Information may have been disclosed to a person or persons not authorized to receive it under the terms of this Protective Order, the person subject to this Protective Order must immediately notify the Constellation Respondents and the PSC in writing of the unauthorized disclosure; identify which Constellation Confidential Information was disclosed, the date of disclosure, and the person or persons to whom the unauthorized disclosure was made; give detailed information concerning all steps taken or being taken to reverse or minimize the impacts of unauthorized release; and make reasonable efforts to recover any such Constellation Confidential Information released to such unauthorized person or persons.
- b. The Petitioner responsible for the unauthorized disclosure must also file with the Court a sworn statement detailing the circumstances regarding the unauthorized disclosure and the steps being taken to prevent any further unauthorized disclosures.
- c. Petitioners acknowledge that the Constellation Respondents have stated that Constellation Confidential Information is extremely commercially sensitive and that its disclosure will cause "substantial injury to Constellation's commercial position," as described in the Affidavit of Jeanne Jones dated April 18, 2018, and

the Affirmation of Victoria Graffeo dated April 26, 2018, each filed with the Court on April 26, 2018. In the event of an unauthorized disclosure, Petitioners agree to submit to the jurisdiction of this Court for purposes of enforcement of this Protective Order, including through (but not limited to) sanction, contempt proceedings, and/or injunctive relief. Persons responsible for unauthorized disclosure may also be liable criminally or civilly under relevant federal and State statutes and regulations.

### 6. Miscellaneous

- a. This agreement is governed by New York law, and any dispute arising out of this agreement shall be brought in New York Supreme Court, Albany County.
- b. If any Petitioner receives a subpoena or other legal process purporting to require the production of Constellation Confidential Information, that Petitioner shall provide notice to the Constellation Respondents' outside counsel within five business days of receipt.
- c. Within 30 days of the termination of this litigation, including any appeals, any person who received Constellation Confidential Information pursuant to this Protective Order must certify in writing to counsel for the Constellation Respondents and counsel for the PSC that the Petitioner has destroyed all documents and materials and the portions of all other material containing Constellation Confidential Information, and that any electronic copies of the Constellation Confidential Information or electronic files (including electronic communications) that include the Constellation Confidential Information have been deleted. Notwithstanding these provisions, outside counsel shall be

permitted to retain copies of court filings, papers served in connection with this Litigation, transcripts, and exhibits, provided that outside counsel continues to limit disclosure as provided in this Protective Order.

- d. This Scheduling Stipulation may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but together shall constitute one and the same agreement.
   An electronic signature shall be deemed an original.
- e. This Protective Order may be amended by the agreement of counsel for the parties in the form of a stipulation and order that shall be filed in this case. Any party may apply to the Court for a modification of this Protective Order. This Protective Order shall remain in full force and effect after the termination of this litigation, or until canceled or otherwise modified by Order of this Court.
